Fall 2020 Semester

In light of the current remote teaching mandate, ARH Undergraduate course fees previously associated with onsite classes and studios have been temporarily reduced or waived and all ARH Grad course fees are temporarily waived for virtual classes in Fall 2020. We expect students to purchase materials and tools for remote model building as communicated in each class. If students need a studio-desk, remote lab access or shop access, students may access these resources by choice for the fees below.

Course fees have previously supported access to the Brannan computer labs, woodshop and studio spaces. Studio and Woodshop Facilities for Architecture students will now be offered at 1849 Washington ("The Warehouse") instead of at 601 Brannan. Through Peoplesoft we now offer a choice of resources to all OS Virtual and Online students. We encourage students to consider these choices to fully support their education for FA 2020.

Strict COVID protocols will be honored when students are working at 1849 Washington.

INDIVIDUAL DEDICATED STUDIO DESK AT 1849 WASHINGTON

FEE: \$25 FOR THE SEMESTER

Students will be offered a dedicated desk at 1849 Washington ("The Warehouse") for their personal use throughout the semester and will be required to reserve access through an online reservation system at least 48 hours in advance of the time they would be working at 1849 Washington. 1849 Washington. Studios will be open 5 days per week Tues -Sat. Times of Opening are Subject to Change.

*** Drop-in studios desks are available for one-off usage through Open Studio Reservations. Students reserving these desks cannot leave any items at 1849 Washington.

ARH WOODSHOP ACCESS AT 1849 WASHINGTON

FEE: \$125 FOR THE SEMESTER

Students will have access to the 1849 Washington Woodshop all semester and will be required to reserve time through an online reservation system at least 48 hours in advance. Times will be reserved in increments of 4 hours. The Woodshop Hours will be posted on the reservation system and on the Architecture Blog. The 1849 Washington Woodshop will be open and staffed 5 days per week Tuesday through Saturday. Times of Opening are Subject to Change. Architecture students will have access for hand tools and machinery most typically used for architecture studio with additional access to specialty machinery and tools for small additional fees. Materials can be purchased separately.

VIRTUAL LAB AND SOFTWARE ACCESS

FEE: \$200 FOR THE SEMESTER**

We have established a virtual remote lab available to all students through Teradici. Students work on their projects from their computer at home and can harness all the power of a workstation from our lab; including the use of RAM, CPU, internet speed, network hard drives, high-end software programs, and licenses. This virtual remote lab mirrors our onsite labs. Time will be reserved in advance and limited in the length of each time slot.

Teradici Requirements:

- Stable internet connection
- Windows 7 / 8.1 / 10
- MacOS Sierra / Mac OSX El Capitan
 - Choose *Virtual Lab Access Fee* on the Peoplesoft dropdown menu.
- **Students in these undergrad studios and courses have a course fee incorporated giving them automatic access to the computer lab remotely via Teradici.

PC COMPUTER CHECK-OUT

FEE: \$300 FOR THE SEMESTER

If it is determined that a student needs a PC computer for the semester, we are pleased to offer our Academy computers that they may check-out and take home for a fee. The computer and all equipment loaned, such as display monitor, cables or other incidentals may be requested through their Academic Department Director and requires Director approval. Paid through the student's PeopleSoft account, and Picked up from the 79 New Montgomery Issue Room located on the 1st floor. As student's enter the building please ask the Campus Host for directions to the issue room.

Requirements:

- An internet router to plug in an ethernet cable (WiFi not available on loaned Lab PCs)
 - Students may use their own USB WiFi adapter if an ethernet cable connection is not possible
- Windows 7 / 8.1 / 10
- MacOS Sierra / Mac OSX El Capitan
 - Choose **ARH Computer Check-out** on the Peoplesoft dropdown menu.

- ***Note: if a student checks out a PC computer for the semester the student will have the software required for their classes already loaded onto the computer and will not likely not be required to purchase or have an additional remote lab fee. – Check with James Ryan. jryan@academyart.edu
