- 1. Floor plans, sections, site plans
- 2. Physical models
- 3. Freehand sketches
- 4. Diagrams used as a conceptual design tool Diagrams can be drawings or models, 2D or 3D
- 5. Representation of topography in a drawing and/or model
- 6. Site analysis
- 7. Program diagrams
- 8. Precedent analysis
- 9. **List all software programs used** We are looking for Photoshop, Illustrator, AutoCad, Rhino, Revit, Enscape, Twinmotion.

If you are transferring from a NAAB-accredited program, most of your architecture courses will transfer. To aid the review process, please attach a degree break down and highlight the courses you have taken. Most architecture schools publish a semester-by-semester breakdown of required courses on their websites.
